FAMOUS IMMIGRANT REQUIREMENTS

Below is a list of information you will be required to gather about your immigrant. I will provide you with specific note taking sheets.

- Full Name
- Date and place of birth
- Family Information/Education/Other Background Information
- When they came to America
- Why they came to America
- Profession (job) in America
- Did/will they become a citizen?
- Treatment in America as an immigrant/challenges and struggles they faced
- Accomplishments/Contributions to America

In addition to information about your immigrant, you will also be making a "water bottle doll" replica of your immigrant. Directions for that will follow!

CULTURAL MARKERS REQUBREMENT

You will also be gathering information on some cultural markers important to your immigrant's country of origin. These are things that an immigrant from this particular country may have brought with them to America in hopes of retaining their culture. As we have discussed, America is a nation shaped by the cultures of the many that have come into our country.

You will be required to report out on three of the four listed below. Specific guidelines will follow.

- Cultural food
- Cultural celebration/festival/holiday
- Cultural craft
- Cultural game

FRISSHED PRODUCT

Your finished product will be in the form of a **<u>SCRAPBOOK</u>**. This will be a bound book (think along the lines of a small binder with sheet protectors) that will contain all of the required information. See the sheet provided with instructions as to how to set this up. In addition to the scrapbook, you will also have your immigrant doll to accompany the scrapbook (again, see the separate instructions for this piece).

Finished product will include:

- 1. Famous Immigrant information (see the front again for required information).
- 2. Picture of your immigrant and other pictures relevant to their story.
- 3. Your doll replica with a name tag.
- 4. Information about three of the four cultural markers (see below).

Food:

- Name of food
- Explanation of its origin or importance to the cultural group
- Recipe (including list of ingredients and directions to make it)
- Pictures of the food. You can also make and bring in the food, but your scrapbook must have pictures.

Celebration/Festival/Holiday:

- Name of celebration/festival/holiday
- Explanation of its origin or importance to the cultural group
- What occurs during it
- You must have pictures in your scrapbook and you can also make artifacts that represent it.

Craft:

- Name of the craft
- Explanation of its origin or importance to the cultural group
- Supplies needed
- Directions as to how to make it
- You must have pictures of the craft. You can also make the actual craft and bring it in.

Game:

- Name of the game
- Explanation of its origin or importance to the cultural group
- Materials needed to play
- Directions for how to play
- You must have pictures of the game. You can also make the actual game and bring it in.

REMEMBER

This is your last project this year. Do you want to be proud of your final piece of work? Include as many pieces as you would like. Feel free to go above and beyond if you find something that is of interest to you in regards to this culture.

The Book:

Please have a solid "book" to use as your scrapbook. Think along the lines of a small binder (1/2 inch) with sheet protectors. You can also ask me to bind it using the library binding machine, but that must be PRIOR to the due date. Any other ideas you have, please run them by me first! **<u>BE CREATIVE</u>**!

Cover:

The cover of your scrapbook should include:

- □ The name of your immigrant.
- □ Their country of origin.
- Your name.
- □ Appropriate illustrations (at least one must be a picture of the immigrant)
- □ Anything else you think is needed to make it stand out!

Pages 1-3 (page 2 is on the back of page 1)

These three pages are for your immigrant's biographical piece.

- □ Include your TYPED written narrative you worked on with Mrs. Kelly. Refer to the checklist for requirements.
- □ Include plenty of images that relate to your immigrant and their story.

Pages 4-5 (page 4 is on the back of page 3)

These two pages are for your first cultural marker.

- □ Include your TYPED written information. Refer to the checklist for requirements
- □ Include images that relate to this cultural marker.

Pages 6-7 (page 6 is on the back of page 5)

These two pages are for your second cultural marker.

- □ Include your TYPED written information. Refer to the checklist for requirements
- □ Include images that relate to this cultural marker.

Pages 8-9 (page 8 is on the back of page 7)

These two pages are for your third cultural marker.

- □ Include your TYPED written information. Refer to the checklist for requirements
- □ Include images that relate to this cultural marker.
